- Is no more than six months old from date of acquisition

Stationary Agricultural Equipment:

- Has less than 750 hours of service
- Is no more than 60 days from acquisition

#### **Application Process**

Follow these three easy steps to enroll equipment in the New Equipment Warranty.

- 1. Complete and sign the New Equipment Warranty Application and Agreement of Responsibility form (the "Application and Agreement") at the back of this booklet.
- 2. Work with your authorized distributor to submit the Application and Agreement, plus the warranty fee of \$299, to CHS for processing. As the warranty applicant, payment must come from you. CHS reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to approve or disapprove any Application and Agreement submitted for approval.
- 3. CHS will review your Application and Agreement and notify you if it is approved by sending you an Approval Welcome Kit detailing your coverage and containing tools to assist you in maintaining your warranty coverage.

#### **WARRANTY TRANSFER**

#### **Transferring Coverage**

Existing coverage can be transferred to a new owner provided that all prior Operator responsibilities have been fulfilled. Transfer request must be made within 30 days of acquisition of the transferred equipment. Coverage is limited to the original warranty term.

Contact your authorized Cenex distributor to begin the transfer process.

#### **Coverage Length**

Equipment is covered until it reaches specified years in service from date of manufacture or it accumulates specified hours, whichever occurs first.

For example, for 8 years/8,000 hours of coverage, if your equipment has accumulated 2 years/1,400 hours, the remaining coverage is 6 years or 6.600 hours.

**IMPORTANT:** The used equipment protection plan requires two, approved LubeScan® oil analysis fluid samples within 24 months to verify equipment is in good condition before the plan is activated.

**Please note:** The use of Cenex® Ruby Fieldmaster® within the protection plan includes the use of Cenex® Ruby Fieldmaster® Seasonally Enhanced and Cenex® Wintermaster®.

#### Winter-blending Ruby Fieldmaster®:

When #1 Ruby Fieldmaster® is available, Cenex Total Protection Plan® holders are required to use this product when blending with Ruby Fieldmaster® for seasonal purposes. The use of an untreated #1 distillate with Ruby Fieldmaster® may void your coverage.

#### **USED EQUIPMENT APPLICATION AND APPROVAL PROCESS**

#### **USED EQUIPMENT WARRANTY**

#### **Application Qualifiers**

USED Equipment is defined as equipment that:

- Does not meet the requirements of "New"
- Has less than 8 years and 8,000 hours of service
- Has a minimum of 25 horsepower (diesel only)

#### Coverage Levels Eligibility:

Used Equipment **Basic Coverage**: Up to 8 years old from date of manufacture or 8,000 hours, whichever comes first

Used Equipment **Expanded Coverage**: Up to 2 years old from date of manufacture or 2,000 hours, whichever comes first

#### **Application Process**

- Complete and sign the Used Equipment Warranty Application and Agreement of Responsibility (the "Application and Agreement") at the back of this booklet.
- 2. Arrange for an Authorized Cenex® Distributor representative from your authorized dealer to:
  - Assist you completing an identification inspection of the equipment to be covered, and include a LubeScan® engine oil sample for submission to CHS. If applicable, also submit LubeScan samples for the transmission and/or hydraulics if applying for Expanded Coverage. LubeScan Used Oil Analysis sampling kits are available from your Authorized Cenex Distributor.
  - Verify date of manufacture of equipment and accumulated operating hours.
- 3. Work with your Authorized Cenex Distributor representative to submit the Application and Agreement and a check for the warranty fee of \$399. As the warranty applicant, payment must come from you. In addition, work with your representative to submit the engine oil sample to CHS.

CHS reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to approve or disapprove any Application and Agreement submitted for approval.

- 4. CHS will test and analyze the fluid sample. If no evidence of mechanical defects in lubricated-covered components is detected, the equipment will begin a 100-hour screening period during which the equipment Operator agrees to:
  - Replace all applicable covered fluids with approved Cenex products.
  - Operate the covered equipment in a normal fashion, in normal operating conditions.
  - Submit a second engine oil and/or transmission/ hydraulic fluid sample(s) (following the 100-hour screening period) to CHS for analysis.
- 5. CHS will review the second set of fluid samples along with the Application and Agreement and notify you if the second set of fluid samples are approved by sending you an Approval Welcome Kit detailing your coverage and tools for maintaining your warranty coverage. A Used Equipment Warranty number will be assigned for use in identifying oil samples and to expedite related correspondence.











## DIESEL FUEL INJECTION PUMP AND INJECTORS

Not Covered: Fuel line and filters








Illustration of covered parts.

**Not Covered:** Auxiliary equipment, including added implements and their associated valves and pumps; bogie and idler wheels; reaction/torsion arms; hydraulic lines; couplers; and cab, seating, and steering hydraulics




Illustration of covered parts.



#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### 1. How do I sample my oil?

A: Sample the oil at the time of draining, while the unit is still warm. A sample can be obtained by letting some (approximately 1 quart) of the oil out of the drain plug, then catch it with the sample bottle. Fill the sample bottle and replace cap immediately. Please use the pre-printed ALS bottle labels from your Approval Welcome Kit, or a Sample Identification Form (included with official LubeScan® sample kits available from your authorized Cenex® distributor) when submitting samples to ALS Tribology to ensure that your LubeScan sample is processed correctly. Mail a labeled sample container to ALS Tribology lab using a black mailing canister and/or mailing sleeve to: LubeScan, 935 Sunshine Road, Kansas City, KS, 66115-1122.

#### 2. What are the sample requirements?

A: Used oil samples are required for each warrantied compartment per the frequency listed in your official warranty Agreement, at the time of making a claim under the warranty, or at any time as requested by CHS. Samples must be submitted in official LubeScan sample kit containers available from your local authorized Cenex distributor.

#### 3. Can the warranty transfer?

A: Existing coverage can be transferred to a new owner provided that all prior Operator responsibilities have been fulfilled. A transfer request must be made within 30 days of acquisition of the transferred equipment. Coverage is limited to the original warranty term.

#### 4. How do I make a claim?

A: If a covered part shows signs of failure, you should notify your authorized Cenex distributor immediately. A sample of the relevant Cenex lubricant must be sent through the LubeScan process for evaluation. If applicable, a fuel sample must be submitted in an approved fuel test kit, along with proofs-of-purchase from an authorized Cenex® Ruby Fieldmaster® distributor. CHS must approve the service center and give authorization prior to repair or replacement of the internal part(s). After the service has been completed, you will submit the invoice to CHS for payment.

The warranty holder must submit an invoice for the claim within 90 days from final invoice date or claim faces possible rejection. Claims submitted after six months past final invoice date are subject to CHS review and possible rejection.

## 5. Do I have to use both Cenex lubricants and Cenex Ruby Fieldmaster Premium Diesel Fuel? What if one is not available in my area?

A: No. Lubricants-only and Fuels-only coverage options are available in certain geographical areas for both new and used equipment. Work with your authorized Cenex distributor to learn more about obtaining Cenex Total Protection Plan® coverage in these unique situations.
